II. Review and Adopt minutes

IV. Public Comment

V. Financial Report

a) Expenditures, budget, past due accounts

There are currently 10 delinquent accounts (greater than 90 days past due) and the total amount due for these accounts is \$47,582. Of these accounts, four have water shut off, three also have liens, and two are on payment plans.

b) Update on financial audit

Audit should be completed by the end of June. The auditor will present final audit to the Board next month.

VI. Water Report

a) Water report

Tyler

Total treated water production for May (31 days) was 1,623,400 gallons. Average daily production was 52,368 gallons per day. The flow in Moody Gulch during May has stabilized since the last rain events and is flowing at 150% over demand. The raw water turbidity for water entering the plant for May ranged from 0.96 to 1.48 NTU. The average monthly finished water NTU was 0.041 NTU (0.3 NTU is the maximum turbidity allowed by the state). The plant ran at 76% for 29 days of operation.

b) Aqua-Tech for tank sealing

Work will be scheduled soon.

c) Valve replacement program

Tyler

Have a valve targeted for next replacement. Looking to have this scheduled mid-late summer.

d) State survey results and treatment citation

David / Tyler

The State Water Resources Control Board performed a sanitary survey of the water system on May 17th. They summarized their findings in a letter, which requires a response by August 30th. As part of these findings, we received a citation dated May 24, 2016 and are required to send out an official notice that has been approved by the state. David and Tyler are working on the notification, which will be sent out within 30 days.

To address one of the findings, David made a motion for funds not to exceed \$2,000 for Doug Allen of Wy'east Engineering to work on a design for a new main pump and back up. Richard seconds motion. Motion passed.

VII. Roads

a) Comanche / Delaware Status
