To: The Community of Chemeketa Park,

The Santa Clara County Fire Safe Council will be managing a roadside edge clearing project along the entire length of Ogallala Warpath Trail. The project start date is **Monday, December 21, 2020, through Tuesday, December 22, 2020.** Work will begin each day at **8:00AM** and end around **3:00PM** on both days.

The goal of the project is to reduce flammable vegetation along Ogallala Warpath Trail to create a roadside

edge fuel break. This will reduce the risk of roadside fire ignition, improve visibility and enhance travel safety for pedestrians, bicycles, vehicles and emergency apparatus.

Crews will start work at the Upper/South Ogallala entrance near the water storage tanks and work north towards the Lower/North Ogallala entrance of Chemeketa Park. There will be traffic control personnel directing traffic during the project. Please plan your trips in and out of the community with this project in mind. Be prepared to make adjustments to your normal travel plans along Ogallala Warpath for the project duration. The traffic control crew will endeavor to expedite your travel through the work zone as best they can. Please be respectful of their efforts and assist in making the work zone a safe place for all.
